## Assistant psychology at our scholarship program for girls ages 12 to 17

Responsibilities From May till August we do intakes for new girls. We test 1st graders in

public schools for character (HSPQ), personality (SDQ) and intelligence

(CoVaT). We use SPSS to process all data.

Throughout the year we work with small groups of the girls on items like selfesteem, self awareness, sexual education, drugs, ... and we help them discover and develop their personal skills and talents so they can make a

good choise towards a higher education.

All the teenagers we work with are female and from poor to extremely poor 1-parent families. They are not expected to study but work and add to the family income. They are always at risk of getting pregnant which usually ends their education and chance to a better future.

We support the girls **financially**, by paying all school related expenses, **educationally**, by organizing additional classes depending on their school results, and **emotionally** by encouraging them, offering them a broader horizon and by being positive role models in their lives.
