WaaW is an after school project for 25 children ages 5 to 12 from poor to extremely poor families in Santa Eulalia, a neighborhood in Cusco, Peru.

The pillars of WaaW are education, nutrition and health.

We help the children with their homework, broaden their horizons with activities within monthly themes, develop their social skills and health with daily sports and games outside and we teach them additional classes on a personal level according to their schoolresults and our yearly assessments. They get a healthy snack and meal each day to balance their diets. They have access to dental and medical treatment as needed.
