WaaW is an after school project for 25 children ages 5 to 12 from poor to extremely poor families in Santa Eulalia, a neighborhood in Cusco, Peru.

The parents of our children have usually very little education , live very isolated and are often depressed. They are first or second generation farmers that moved (or fled) to the city and miss a lot of skills for survival in the city.

The families are very often in survival mode which means that any major setback results in them moving or even abandoning their children.

The fact that you work in a totally different culture and language makes the job very challenging. This is not a job for the weak of heart.
