### Requirements

As a coördinator you commit to a minimum of 12 full weeks (Monday to Friday) It is important to communicate with the children and external parties, therefore a minimum Intermediate I (B1) level of Spanish is required.

There are no educational requirements but an education and/or experience in the fields of teaching, social work or animation are a pre.

### Your role

You are responsible for the activities and sports & games. Together with the volunteer coördinator and manager of WaaW, you choose monthly themes and break them down into daily activities. You make sure all materials are present and you train and instruct the mentors. At WaaW you manage the execution of the activities, sports and games.

### Daily schedule

In the morning you work at FairServices to prepare the daily activities and the materials. At our offices we have all modern office equipment and lots of space in a beautiful setting to do a great job.

At 2.30 you are at WaaW to prepare for the daily activities.

Between 3.00 and 5.00 p.m. you manage the activities, sports and games and help the mentors with the execution.
